HOW2Learn Term 4 Week 6 Reasoning




- Being able to effectively explain understanding

If your child's attendance still does not improve without a valid reason, then the Home School Liaison Officer will make contact and an improvement program will be initiated to improve your child's attendance.

Your child's belongings can get easily misplaced at school. Please label all your child's belongings with their name. Do not forget books, pencil cases, clothing and school bags.


#### **IGA Dockets**
