School Dance 2024

We will again be hosting the school dance. It will be held on Tuesday evening, **10th December** at the Tocumwal Memorial Hall. All children from Kinder to Year 6 are invited to attend the dance and are expected to be present at 7.00pm to begin. The students have been practising a variety of dances and we are looking forward to the demonstrations throughout the night.





Parents are always most welcome to stay to watch their children participate in the dancing. There is plenty of seating if you choose to stay.

The dance concludes at 9pm when all children must be met by a parent or designated caregiver to go home.

Children attending must have proper shoes suitable for dancing so that blisters don't spoil their night. Children will also be required to bring their own drink bottle. They can refill with water at the venue.



Outstanding Excursion Payments

If you have not finalised your payments from your child's excursion earlier in the year. Could you please make your payments promptly? This needs to be attended to as the school is finalising our finances for the end of the year and are carrying some family's debt into the new school financial year which is not desirable.

Student Reports

Students' reports will be given out by your child's classroom teacher on Friday 13th December at the end of the school day. These reports will also be available through the Sentral parent portal.



Your child's report describes student achievement in each of the subjects taught in all NSW schools. To prepare the reports, teachers are using a five-point scale to describe the achievement of each student in each subject area over the past two terms. All students in NSW are taught the same NSW Board of Studies syllabuses. Their achievements on these common syllabuses are reported consistently on a five-point Board of Studies scale.

Each school is using five grades - **A-E** - <u>or</u> five-word descriptions - <u>outstanding</u>, <u>high</u>, <u>sound</u>, <u>basic</u> and <u>limited</u> - to summarise the five-point scale of achievement.

These grades tell you how your child is achieving in relation to the material taught in each subject for that semester. They describe the quality of the work your child has produced. They are not a pass/fail scale and do not rank your child in their class, there is no pre-determined number of students who will achieve any of the achievement levels.

Primary Students Pool Afternoon

On Wednesday, 18th December, students in classes Yrs 3-6 only, will be having an afternoon at the Tocumwal Swimming Pool. Classes will walk down to the pool at approximately 1pm. Students will be given supervised free time at the pool. We will be leaving the pool at 2:45pm to return for buses and pickups. Students



who do not have a season pass will be expected to pay the \$3 entry fee. Please ensure your child has appropriate swimwear and a towel. A permission note is included in this week's Newsletter to gain parental /caregiver's permission. Could you please return the slip to the front office with cash payment on or before Monday, 16th December.

No students will be left at the pool. If you want your child to go home directly from the pool a note must be presented to your child's teacher indicating your directions, permission, and your signature.







The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) model is a partnership between communities and NSW Ambulance to improve the health outcomes of patients in regional, rural and remote locations in NSW.

Trained and equipped NSW Ambulance Clinical Volunteers respond to time critical cases where early clinical intervention is known to make a significant difference before paramedics arrive.





To become a NSW Ambulance Clinical Volunteer you are:

- Wanting an opportunity to give back to your community and make a real difference in peoples lives
- Residing or substantially working in the identified location with availability to attend training and respond to incidents.
- Able to meet health,
 vaccination and police check
 requirements

NSW Ambulance Clinical Volunteers are provided with Nationally accredited induction training followed by monthly training, conferences and field exercises.

Clinical Volunteers receive ongoing mentoring from local paramedics and operational management, wellbeing support as well as personal protective equipment, uniform and a NSW Ambulance response vehicle.
